


Ring Size Finder


IMPORTANT: Ensure that the printed paper size is up to correct scale.

- 1. When printing, ensure that print page scaling is set to "NONE" on your print dialog box.
- 2. With a ruler measure the bar on the right to ensure it is exactly 2 inches, or 50 mm.



Method A - Measure Finger With String

- 1. Find a piece of non-stretchy string about 6" long, or a strip of paper about 6" long and 1/4" wide.
- 2. Wrap it snugly around the base of your finger.
- 3. Using a pen, mark the point on the string or paper where it overlaps, forming a complete circle.
- 4. Compare the length of the string or paper to the lines on the paper below to determine your ring size. If you are between sizes, order the larger size.



Method B - Measure Existing Ring

- 1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
- 2. Place the ring over the circles below, matching the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the "inside diameter" of the ring.
- 3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger size.
